

Dr. Narasimhan works for Northwell Health as the Director of Critical Care Services and is an attending in the Division of Pulmonary, Critical Care and Sleep Medicine. She is the Medical Director of the Northwell Acute Lung Injury Center/VV ECMO program. She is a Professor of Medicine at the Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell. She is board certified in internal medicine, pulmonary medicine, critical care medicine and sleep medicine. She has been at Northwell Health for 11 years. Her undergraduate studies were at Barnard College in NY, and medical school was at the University of Health Sciences in Kansas City. She did her residency, chief residency and fellowship at Beth Israel Medical Center, NY.
